EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Houston-Galveston Area Council (H-GAC) cooperative contract pricing has been obtained from Frazer, Ltd. for the refurbishment and remounting of one (1) Type I, 12' generator powered ambulance module onto a 2012 model Ford F-350, 6.7L diesel chassis for use by the EMS department. The ambulance will replace the current unit number TL141, a 2006 Model Frazer unit on a Ford chassis with approximately 150,100 service miles logged. The unit is currently a reserve unit housed at Fire/EMS Station 1, but will be placed back into front-line service after refurbishing. The approximate lead time for completion is approximately 90 days. The H-GAC contract meets all requirements of Local Government Code, Chapter 252 with respect to competitive bidding by Texas municipalities.

The City has applied for a FEMA Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) in an 80:20 federal to local ratio, for this expenditure. If approved, the amount of \$64,440 would be submitted for

reimbursement after delivery and subsequent payment for the unit by the City. Whether the grant is received or not, the City's expenditure will be funded via a future short-term financing arrangement, pursuant to the fiscal year 2012 adopted budget, less the amount received from the grant. City Council approved an Intent to Reimburse from future proceeds at its October 10, 2011 Council meeting

Pursuant to the requirements of the Texas Motor Vehicle Code, the actual provider of the unit will be Frazer's licensed franchise dealer, Sterling McCall Ford of Houston, Texas. Delivery is expected in February, 2012.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

Consideration and approval of a resolution authorizing the refurbishment and remounting of one (1) Frazer, Ltd., generator powered ambulance module, mounted on a new Ford F-350 6.7L diesel chassis from Sterling McCall Ford in the total amount of \$80,550.00, through the H-GAC cooperative purchasing program.
