

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PEARLAND,
TEXAS, SUPPORTING THE 2013 ALVIN ISD BOND ELECTION.**

WHEREAS, The Board of Education of the Alvin Independent School District has called for a bond election to be on the ballot on November 5, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the election is to authorize issuance of general obligation bonds in an amount not to exceed \$212,445,000 for District improvements; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the bond proposition is for the building of new schools, the rebuilding of certain existing schools and other district wide improvements; and

WHEREAS, the District has specifically represented that a portion of the bond proceeds would be used to pay for construction and improvements within the City of Pearland; and

WHEREAS; the City of Pearland has a longstanding commitment to public education, and to the vitality of all of the schools within the City of Pearland and recognizes that the quality and strength of our schools has a direct correlation to the quality and character of our community; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PEARLAND, TEXAS:

Section 1. The Pearland City Council supports the passage of the Alvin Independent School District Bond proposition and the subsequent issuance of bonds for the building and rebuilding of school buildings and for the installation of other improvements within the District.

Section 2. The Pearland City Council encourages the residents of Pearland, within the boundaries of the Alvin Independent School District, to become familiar with the issue and to support the bond proposal in November 5, 2013.
